

AB 516 Temp Tags F&I Reminders



Void (Unwind) Report of Sale

Current Procedure:

When a Report of Sale (ROS) is a VOID/Unwind, a REG 256 must be completed and signed, under penalty of perjury, stating the vehicle never left the dealer's possession and was not operated on the operating copy of the REG 397 or REG 51, and the reason it was voided.

AB516 Effective January 1, 2019:

The current VOID (Unwind) procedure outlined above will be conducted in automated format, however, the system will require approval by the dealership manager or owner when a dealership employee voids a ROS.

Temporary License Plates (TLP):

Effective 1/1/2019 TLP are issued on new vehicles, California used vehicles without two license plates, out of state vehicles (Non-Resident), or vehicles that will have a DP or Personal Plate reassignment, etc. If TLP is issued for a transaction and the ROS is marked Unwind the system will void the TLP. The dealership must confirm in the system that any TLP printed will be destroyed and acknowledge in the system.

Rollbacks

Current Procedure:

Report of Sale is marked "Rollback" with chain of ownership and Rollback Statement of Facts.

AB516 Effective January 1, 2019:

Dealership must mark a Report of Sale form as a Rollback and select reasons for the rollback. If TLP printed and the ROS was marked rollback the system will mark any TLP issued as voided. System will require approval by the dealership manager or owner when a dealership employee marks ROS as a Rollback. Rollback S/F and ownership chain still required.
